Story Bags

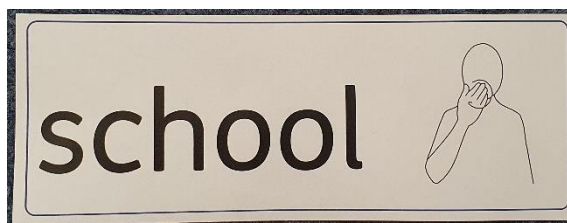
