
Message from Federation Headteachers

We have recently attended a briefing on the worrying rise of cases of measles. Measles cases in the UK have been rising since November 2023. While Hertfordshire has seen few cases so far, we are close to London and other areas where there has been a large rise in cases. The UK Health Security Agency has declared the increase in cases of measles a national incident. There is the potential for cases and outbreaks in Hertfordshire as uptake of the Measles Vaccination (MMR) in the county is lower than recommended. We would urge you to read the letter sent out with this newsletter so that you are fully aware of symptoms and where further advice can be found.

Curriculum - Why we do what we do - Play Dough

What we do at school

The play dough area is a popular area of the Nursery School. At some point all of our children experience making the dough as a group! Making play dough involves following instructions in sequence, measuring, and estimating ingredients then pouring, mixing and kneading. Think of all the learning in that! Play dough engages a range of children's senses including touch and smell. Playing with the dough helps children to explore different textures, temperatures, and consistencies. Manipulating the dough by squishing, rolling, patting and squeezing, develops fine motor control and hand strength. This is crucial for later tasks such as holding a pen, doing up buttons, using tools etc... Sharing dough encourages children to take turns and collaborate and work together. These social interactions help our children to develop empathy, cooperation, and conflict resolution skills. We love using play dough!



• We will send home the dough making recipe – why not have a go at home! This offers valuable learning alongside an inexpensive resource that can be used for hours!
